LETTER OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

NATIONAL ENERGY BOARD

AND

INSTITUTE OF SEDIMENTARY AND PETROLEUM GEOLOGY

Date: February 6, 1995

This letter documents an agreement reached between the National Energy Board (contact: Andrew Graw) and the Institute of Sedimentary and Petroleum Geology (ISPG) (contact: Elspeth Snow).

1. National Energy Board agrees to the transfer of ownership of approximately 42 grey steel storage cabinets to ISPG's inventory.

When the Yellowknife office closed, these cabinets were shipped to Calgary from Yellowknife in early 1994. They contain the Yellowknife set of washed cuttings for both NWT and YT wells.

- 2. If, at some time in the future, the Governments of the North West Territories and/or the Yukon Territory, wish to claim their samples and have them packed up and shipped north, this will be carried out at their expense.
- 3. The cabinets will not accompany the samples, but remain here at ISPG.
